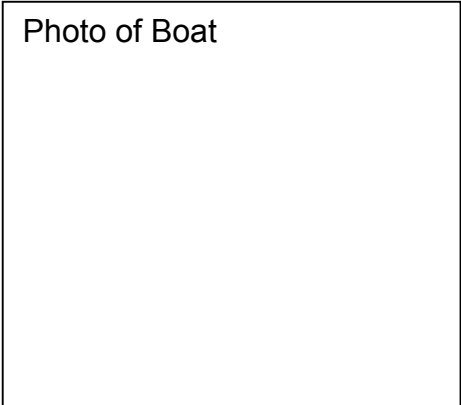

The Hout Bay Yacht Club places the onus on the owner and in some cases the master as well, to **ENSURE** that the vessel and the crew comply with the requirements of the regulations at all times.

Pleasure Vessel: a vessel that is used solely for sport and recreation.

Sailing Vessel: a vessel provided with sufficient sail area for navigation under the sale alone, whether or not fitted with mechanical means of propulsion.

Essential Safety: on every occasion, before the vessel goes to sea, all skippers must ensure that all persons aboard receive essential and appropriate safety information, such as location of safety equipment/appliances. All safety equipment/appliances are fit and ready for use.

Operational Limits: No person may operate a vessel beyond the distance from shore for the category. Ensure the vessels structure, equipment appliances arrangements continue to be in compliance as declared.

Safety Appliances and Equipment for daylight operations:

Buoyancy Aid - PFD one per person.

- SANS/ISO 12402-5 level 50 (competent swimmers)
- fitted with 1 whistle
- 2 lifting loops
- 3 retro reflecting material

Projectile flare set: unexpired and containing a minimum of 6 pencil flares

Handheld smoke marker: unexpired, approved

Fire Extinguisher: one per engine

Full set of sails

Proper patent anchor and chain: at least 5m chain plus rope 50m

Recommended:

- Portable waterproof VHF radio or cell phone in waterproof pouch
- Suitable magnetic compass and or hand bearing compass
- Signal mirror
- Fog horn
- 1 litre water per person
- Appropriate spares and tools
- Bailing bucket (metal)

All Safety Equipment must be marked with the vessels name or number.
